Re: Well Drilling Permit No. 0993-155 for the
construction of Y-4A as a replacement of
Y-4, located behind Yigo Amusement Park.



You are hereby notified that the Guam Environmental Protection Agency has approved the proposed well drilling on the above subject lot(s), with the following conditions:

1. *The well drilling shall be done in strict compliance with the provisions of the Water Resources Development and Operating Regulations (WRDOR). Whenever a condition stated herein conflicts with any provision of the WRDOR, the condition herein shall govern.*
2. *The permittee/driller shall notify the Administrator or his authorized representative when drilling work of the well (including installation of the casing) is completed, but prior to the installation of any equipment or appurtenances on/or in the well.*
3. *The permittee/driller shall keep a continuous log of the drilling of the well, including description(s) and sample(s) of the materials encountered together with the depth of the top and bottom of each change in geological characteristics. The log shall include a record of water levels encountered, any changes thereof and the rate of flow at the surface, if any, for different depths of drilling and a log of time for every foot drilled.*
4. *The permittee/driller shall submit a driller's report to the Administrator on forms satisfactory to the Administrator within thirty (30) days after the construction of the well and representative samples of rock materials penetrated during drilling.*
5. *If information discloses that there is a basis to expect that the well drilling caused contamination or wastage of groundwater resources, the permittee/driller shall complete the work (at his own expense) in a manner satisfactory to the Administrator.*
6. *The job-site shall be properly secured at all times and that the permittee/driller shall be responsible for providing safeguards (at his own expense) so that any person permitted to be present on the well drilling site will not be exposed to any danger or nuisance.*
